



## **PRACTICAL WAYS TO POINT PEOPLE TO JESUS**

Pointing people to Jesus is the act of directing attention to Jesus and emphasizing His importance. And if we are going to be effective pointing people to Jesus, then you and I need to be saved, in close fellowship with Jesus constantly nurturing and deepening our relationship with Jesus, and with one another. Listed below are 7 practical ways saved people can be used by God to point people to Jesus so that they may experience a new beginning.

- 1. Share Your Faith (tell others your testimony of how Jesus came into your life and saved you. Share evangelism tracts (like when you go to a restaurant and pay for your meal, add a gospel tract and/or church invite card with your tip).**
- 2. Engage in conversations with people by asking: “How can you pray for them.”**
- 3. Wear Christian apparel: hats, t-shirts, etc. that point to Jesus.

- 4. Invite people to join you on the S.H.O.P (Sweet Hour of Prayer) Tuesday teleconference and/or one of our three corporate Bible studies (Wednesday Noonday in person at the church, Wednesday evening Bible study via web ex teleconference, and Sunday Morning Bible Study).**

5. Lovingly and in the appropriate setting confront sin: people need to recognize their sins, and they need “the Savior.” And we must do this with **John 3:17** (*For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.*) and **1 John 1:9** (*If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness*) in mind. People must know they have a meeting date with Jesus they cannot avoid. **Hebrews 9:27** says, *“And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment.”*
6. Engage in Acts of Kindness. And when you do it, be sure to let people know it was the Holy Spirit that prompted you to do it. Most people don’t care about what you know about Jesus until you show them you care about them.
7. Ask people to take action: Be clear about what you want people to do such as: attend a Bible teaching/preaching church like TMFBC and after you talk to them about the Romans Road to Salvation, ask the person to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Don’t be afraid to ask people to do what Jesus desires all people to do (give their life to Him).

The path to salvation means you must travel down the “**Romans Road to Salvation**” – these are critical verses from the book of Romans to share with those seeking to know Jesus. **Romans 3:23** *“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”* **Romans 5:8** – *“But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”* **Romans 6:23** – *“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”* **Romans 10:9** – *“If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”* **Romans 10:13** – *“For “whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.”*

Daily pray for God to send you **divine appointments** that He has prepared you to share the Gospel with those He sends into your sphere of influence.
